The presented papers will be published, after the usual refereeing process, in the Journal of Optoelectronics and Advanced Materials (ISI impact factor for 2005 1.138) or in the Annals of Iasi University.

Travel

City of Iasi is easily accessible by plane, train and car. There are three daily flights from Bucharest to Iasi (operated by Tarom) and external flights are running from/to Italy and Germany, operated by Carpatair (via Timisoara). A daily direct flight of Austrian Airlines from Vienna is also available. About five trains a day connect Bucharest to Iasi and the journey takes six hours.
